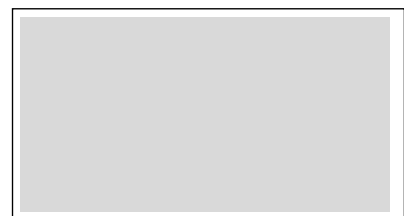




Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeal

The Higher Education Act of 1965 requires institutions of higher education to establish and apply standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) that all students must meet to qualify and remain eligible for assistance from Title IV (Federal) student financial aid programs. Academic history is reviewed for all students applying for financial aid, regardless of whether financial aid has been previously received. At UNCSA Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) is measured at the end of each term. In order to receive federal financial aid funds, students must meet the following three requirements.
